## PARENTS/GUARDIANS ATTENDANCE

### Mini Age Groups (Under 12's and below)

As a parent or designated adult, you **MUST remain on site throughout the session** they are attending. Attendance includes home training, matches, away matches and all the tournaments that your child participates in. In practice, this means that if you decide to leave your child's pitch for a break or, to visit a sibling in another age group, you must make the management team aware and designate another adult in the group (with whom your child is familiar) to cover until your return. Regardless of this, when your child attends, they must always be contactable (mobile) in the event of an incident/injury involving their child.

# FIRST AIDERS



Clubs and all organisers of rugby activities have a responsibility towards the health and safety of players.

Every team throughout the club has fully qualified emergency first aiders who have a minimum Level 3 First Aid Qualification. They will take charge and provide emergency first aid to injured or ill persons until more expert help arrives.

They will make the decision to remove a child from play if they believe it is in a child's best interests, this cannot be overruled.

## Headcase

Recognised as one of the UK's leading concussion awareness and education resources, the RFU's HEADCASE programme aims to increase understanding and provide information on concussion and other related topics, including how to prevent and manage suspected concussions.
